

## Employer of the Year Award: Selection Guidelines

Service and sponsorship are the two main criteria used to select the recipient of the Career Services Employer of the Year award.

The employer of the year award recognizes an organization's ongoing support of the University in general and Career Services in particular. The organization's involvement includes but certainly should not be limited to:

Continuing recruitment of WSU students for professional development and careers  
Chapter membership in the WSU President's Associates for Career Services (Crimson level)  
Membership of Career Services' Employer council  
Sponsorship of the highly successful "Be a Star!" Etiquette Dinner  
Participation in mock interviews in conjunction with Spring and Fall Career Expos  
Annually attends both Fall and Spring Career Expos  
Participation in on-campus interviewing for full-time employees and interns  
Conducting group informational meetings and class/student organization presentations

The benefits of being "Employer of the Year" include the following:

- A complimentary table at the "Be a Star!" Etiquette Dinner
- A complimentary booth at one Career Expo (either Spring or Fall)
- The right to display the "Employer of the Year" banner at the Career Expo and other events. The banner is provided by Career Services
- Special recognition on Career Services' website
- Special recognition on the Career Services' Wall of Honor. This could be a picture or logo. The dimensions should be 9.75" wide by 8.75" high
- A certificate of achievement
